

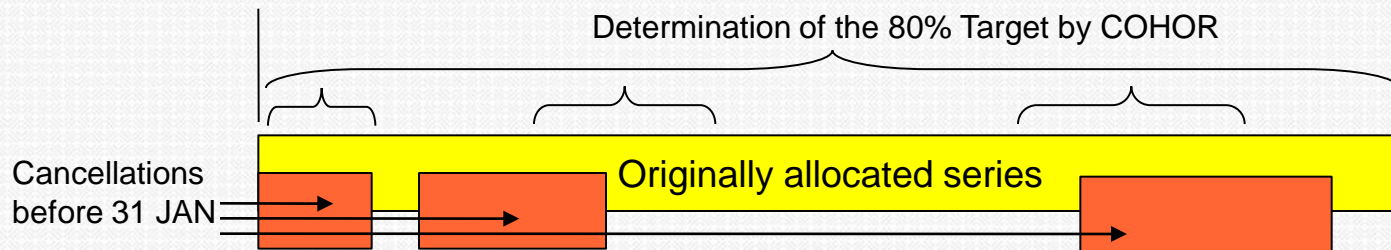

Basis for the calculation of historic slots by Cohor



Cancellations made before 31 August (Winter) and 31 January (Summer)

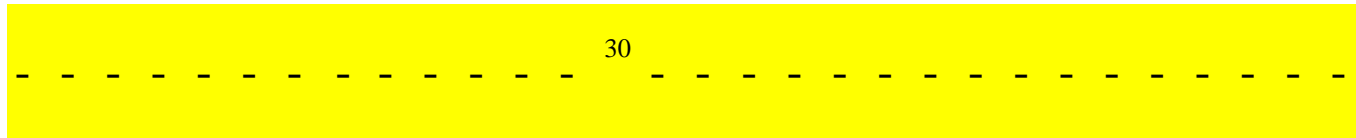
- The cancellation of 5 or more consecutive weeks will reduce the period eligible for historic precedence or result in separate periods eligible for historic precedence. Where the separate periods are recognized as part of the same service (for example, same flight number, route, etc.) then the 80% usage will be calculated for the total number of operations across all periods. (Examples 1,2,3).
- The cancellation of periods of less than 5 consecutive weeks does not reduce the period eligible for historic precedence, provided the total number of cancellations is 20% or less of the period between the first and last date of the series of slots. (Examples 4 to 10).

If target of at least 80% of 25 is reached at the end of season

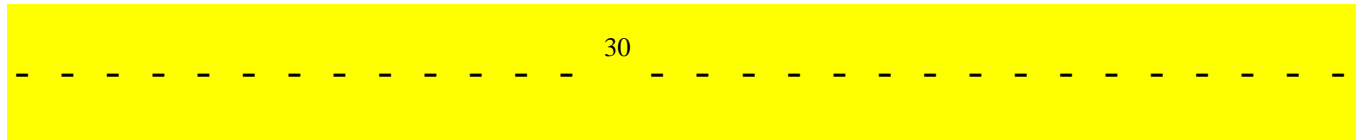
In this example, the cancellation of 5 consecutive weeks prior to 31 JAN results in two separate periods eligible for historic precedence. The separate periods are recognisably part of the same service. Therefore the 80% usage will only be calculated for the total number of operations across the two periods $5 + 20 = 80\%$ of 25. Failing to meet the target will result in losing both periods even if all cancellations after 31JAN are focused on one of the two period.

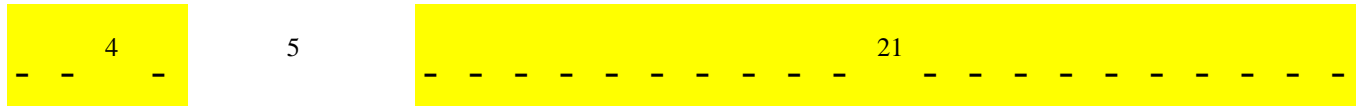

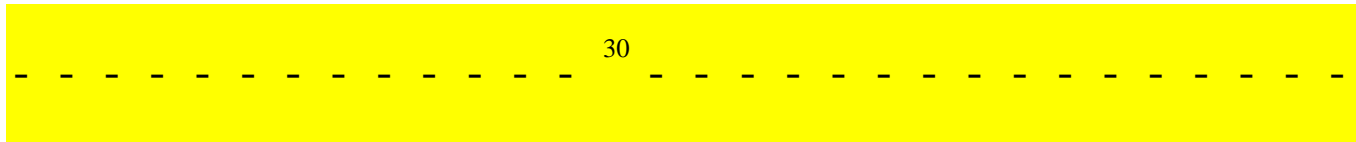
In this example, the cancellation of 5 consecutive weeks prior to 31 JAN reduces the period eligible for historic precedence to 21 weeks. The first period of 4 weeks is not eligible for historic precedence. The target will be at least 80% of 21 in order to get 21 weeks as historic.

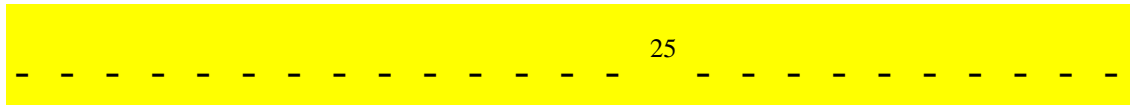

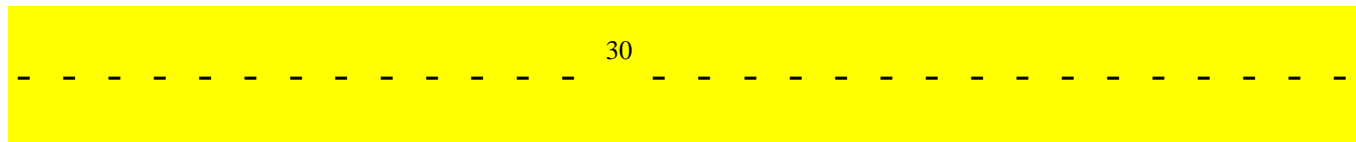
In this example, the cancellation of 5 consecutive weeks prior to 31 JAN reduces the period eligible for historic precedence to 25 weeks. The target will be at least 80% of 25 in order to get 25 weeks as historic.

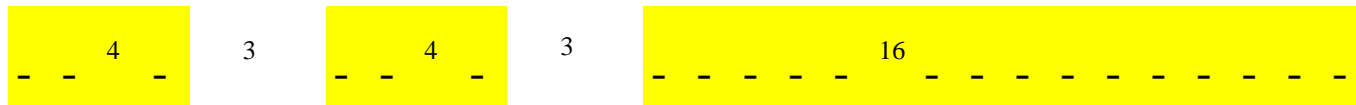

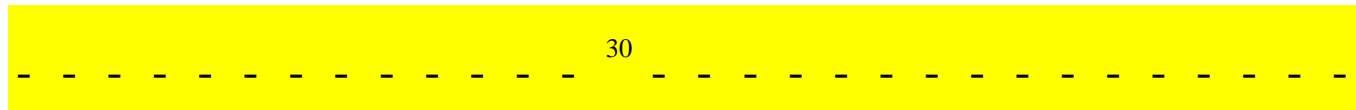

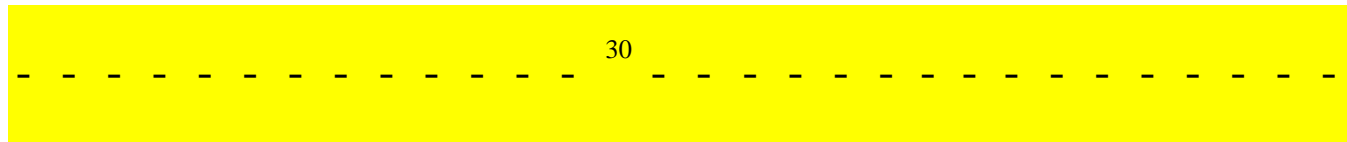
In this example, the cancellation of two periods of 3 weeks prior to 31 JAN represents 20 % of the originally allocated series of 30 weeks. It does not reduce the period of 30 weeks eligible for historic precedence. The target will be at least 80% of 24 in order to get 30 weeks as historic.

5 - Cancellations < 5 consecutive weeks

If target of at least 80% of 19 is reached at the end of season

In this example, the cancellation of the two periods of 3 and 4 weeks prior to 31 JAN exceeds 20 % of the originally allocated series of 30 weeks. Then the 80% usage will be calculated for the total number of operations across the two remaining recognizable periods (5+14) eligible for historic precedence. The target will be at least 80% of 19 in order to get 19 weeks as historic.

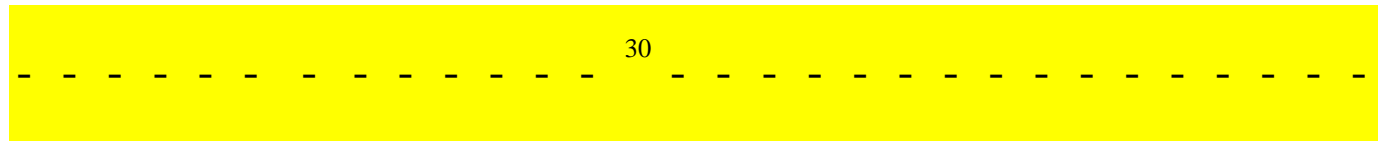
Failing to meet the target will result in losing both periods even if all cancellations after 31 JAN are focused on one of the 2 remaining recognizable periods.

6 – Cancellations < 5 consecutive weeks

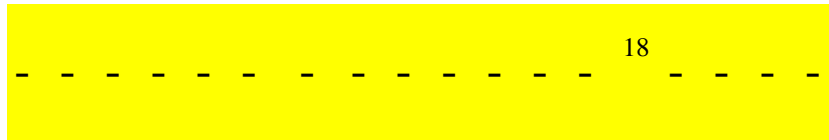
In this example, the cancellation of a period of 4 consecutive weeks prior to 31 JAN represents less than 20 % of the originally allocated series of 30 weeks. It does not reduce the period of 30 weeks eligible for historic precedence. The target will be at least 80% of 26 in order to get 30 weeks as historic.

7 – Cancellation < 5 consecutive weeks

If target of at least 80% of 14 is reached at the end of season

In this example, the cancellation of a period of 4 weeks prior to 31 JAN exceeds 20 % of the originally allocated series of 18 weeks. It reduces the period eligible for historic precedence to 14 weeks.

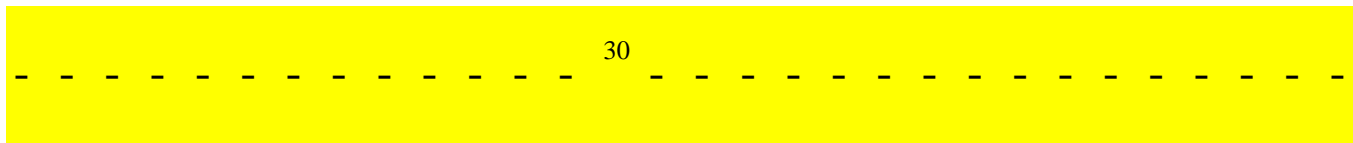
The target will be at least 80% of 14 weeks in order to get 14 weeks as historic.

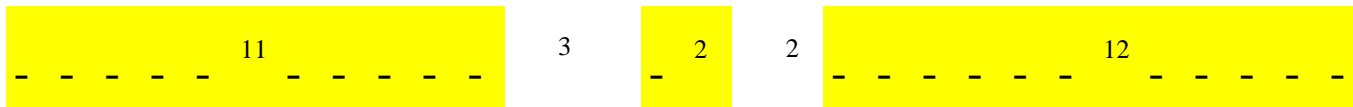

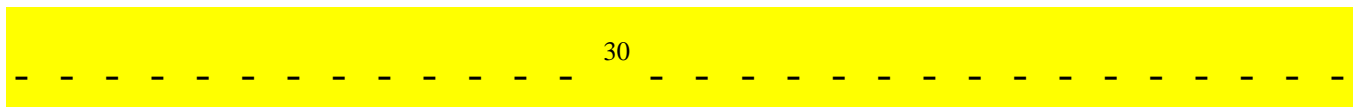

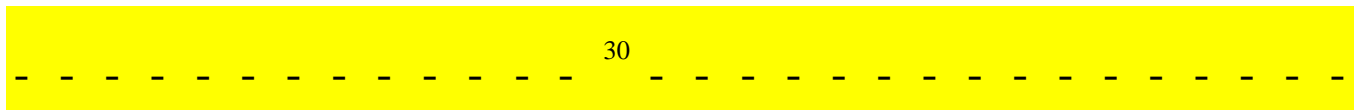
In this example, the cancellation of two periods of 3 and 2 weeks prior to 31 JAN is less than 20 % of the originally allocated series of 30 weeks. It does not reduce the period eligible for historic precedence of 30 weeks. The target will be at least 80% of 25 weeks in order to get 30 weeks of historic.

9 – Cancellations < 5 consecutive weeks

In this example, the cancellation of two periods of 3 and 4 weeks prior to 31 JAN exceeds 20 % of the originally allocated series of 30 weeks. It results in two separate periods of 9 and 11 weeks eligible for historic precedence. These periods are recognisable part of the same service. Then the 80% usage will be calculated for the total number of operations accross the two periods (9+11=20). Target will be at least 80% of 20 in order to get 20 weeks as historic.

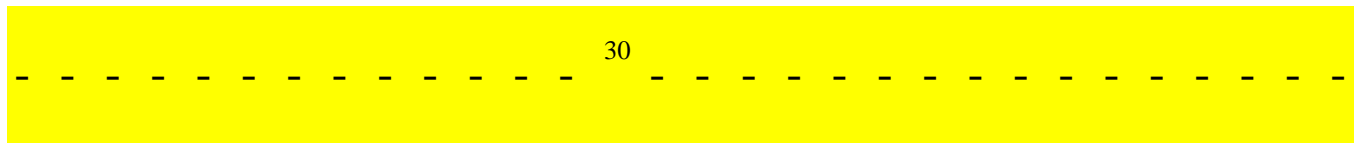
Failing to meet the target will result in losing both periods even if all cancellations after 31 JAN are focused on one of the remaining recognizable periods.

In this example, the cancellation of two periods of 3 and 4 weeks prior to 31 JAN exceeds 20 % of the originally allocated series of 30 weeks. After cancellation, the two periods of 4 consecutive dates remaining are not eligible for historic precedence. Then the 80% usage will be calculated for the total number of operations of the only remaining recognizable period (15) eligible for historic precedence. The target will be at least 80% of 15 in order to get 15 weeks as historic.
