CDG (PARIS/CHARLES DE GAULLE)

Increase of capacity for \$19:

The Paris airports executive Coordination Committee met on September 24th, 2018 and reviewed the coordination parameters at Paris Charles de Gaulle (CDG) for the summer 2019 scheduling season (S19).

The French Civil Aviation (DGAC) consequently decided a slight increase of capacity.

Please refer to COHOR Website for the new detailed coordination parameters applicable at CDG as from S19.

ORY (PARIS / ORLY)

Since 06 October, 1994 a French regulation has limited to 250,000 the total number of slots the Coordinator may allocate for 2 consecutive scheduling periods (Summer and Winter). Each carrier having requested slots at ORY received in the SI part of its SAL its authorized quota for S19 based on 30 weeks.

FSC (FIGARI)

RUNWAY WORKS AT PARIS ORLY AIRPORT DURING \$19

Paris Aéroport needs to make important works on runway 08/26 at Paris Orly airport from end of July 2019 until the beginning of the season W19.

This runway is more than 60 years old and even if some renovation works were regularly made, the runway needs now to be completely demolished (at a depth of almost 1 meter) and rebuilt. The works will be particularly complex because the runway crosses another active runway (02/20) and a major road of Paris area over a bridge.

French Civil Aviation authorities (DGAC), Paris Aéroport and COHOR would like to take the opportunity of the Slot Conference in Madrid to make a joint presentation of the project. The length and the schedule of the works will be presented as well as the impact of the airport capacity and the consequence for carriers.

This presentation will be held during the Slot Conference in the Madrid Marriott Auditorium on Wednesday 14th of November from 16:00 to 17:00 in room Frankfurt.

ORLY PASSENGER TERMINAL NOTIFICATION

On 19 March 2019, a new terminal building will open at Orly Airport In Paris. The new building will connect the current terminals Orly South and Orly West. As a result, the terminals will be redesignated as follows:

Orly-Ouest will be renamed as Orly 1 and Orly 2 New section will be named Orly 3 Orly Sud will be renamed as Orly 4
