

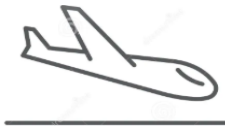
Quick Return Flights (QRF) & Diversions

Operational Guidelines for Aircraft Operators

COHOR applies the same slot management principles to QRF and diversions:



1. The original departure slot is considered used.



2. No arrival slot request is required for the returning flight.



3. No new departure slot request is required if the aircraft re-departs on the same UTC day as the original operation.

Example: **No Additional** Departure Slot Required

- Original Departure: **25 Jun – 19:00 UTC**
- Return Arrival: **25 Jun – 19:15 UTC**
- Subsequent Departure: **25 Jun – 23:55 UTC**

An additional departure slot request is optional for same-day UTC re-departures, except at CDG during the night restriction period, where it is mandatory.

Example: New Departure **Slot Required**

- Original Departure: **25 Jun – 21:00 UTC**
- Return Arrival: **25 Jun – 21:15 UTC**
- Subsequent Departure: **26 Jun – 00:05 UTC**

A new departure slot request is required, as the re-departure takes place on the following UTC day.

IMPORTANT : airport specification must be respected (ex. night restriction at CDG, curfews, etc.)

SLOT MONITORING AFTER OPERATION:

IF THE SLOT MONITORING TEAM REQUESTS CLARIFICATION REGARDING THE RETURN OF A FLIGHT, OPERATORS SHOULD SIMPLY INDICATE:

QRF OR DIVERSION REASON

THIS INFORMATION IS SUFFICIENT TO JUSTIFY THE FLIGHT MOVEMENT.
